RESOLUTION 19-R-43

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT/GOVERNMENT EQUITY (ED/GE) AGREEMENT WITH MONTGOMERY COUNTY OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REGARDING THE HERAEUS PROJECT (AKA PROJECT ZEPPELIN) AND TO ENTER INTO A CORRESPONDING ED/GE AGREEMENT WITH HERAEUS AS THE ED/GE GRANT RECIPIENT

The resolution which bears the foregoing title was unanimously adopted Monday, August 19, 2019, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It authorizes the city manager to enter into an Economic Development/Government Equity (ED/GE) agreement with Montgomery County Office of Economic Development Regarding the Heraeus Project (AKA Project Zeppelin) and to enter into a corresponding ED/GE agreement with Heraeus as the ED/GE grant recipient. The resolution which bears the foregoing title was unanimously adopted Monday, August 19, 2019, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It authorizes the purchase of a 2019 Ford F250 SD Regular Cab 4WD pickup truck with a snow plow and accessories, requested by the Public Works Department, from Beau Townsend Ford in the amount of \$39,263.50 and declares the current 2009 Chevrolet C-3500 4WD pickup truck to be replaced as surplus property. AT THE HGAC BUY CONTRACT PRICE OF \$37,367.30 AND DECLARE OUR CURRENT FORD TS-90 TRACTOR AND MOWER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

The resolution which bears the foregoing title was unanimously adopted Monday, August 19, 2019, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. It authorizes the purchase of a boom mower attachment for the Trackless Series MT7- Municipal Tractor requested by the Public Works Department from Trackless Vehicles, Ltd. at the HGAC Buy Contract price of \$37,367.30 and

It authorizes the city manager or his designee to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s) and authorizes additional action as necessary for the city to participate in such programs with respect to the Northwoods Boulevard and Falls Creek intersection improvements project.
