

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, February 1 meeting:

- Approved Resolution 21-R-05 authorizing a donation of \$15,000 to the Historical Society of Vanda-lia-Butler. This donation is made annually and is appropriated toward all maintenance related projects. It also includes the cost of an annual Business/Organization membership for the City.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-06 authorizing the purchase of a Compact Track Loader from Murphy Tractor and Equipment of Vandalia at the state bid contract price of \$72,500. The City budgeted \$75,000 for this purchase. This purchase is in conjunction with the purchase of a Road Widening Paving Box and Asphalt Mill. All three pieces of equipment will replace a 1992 LeeBoy Asphalt Maintainer that is no longer in production.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-07 authorizing the purchase of a Road Widening Paving Box from Southeastern Equipment Company for \$48,836.52. The City budgeted \$50,000 for this purchase. This purchase is in conjunction with the purchase of a Road Widening Paving Box and Asphalt Mill. All three pieces of equipment will replace a 1992 LeeBoy Asphalt Maintainer that is no longer in production.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-08 authorizing a lease with MetroNet for fiber connection between Fire Station 1 and the Justice Center, which would connect the Recreation Center, Building Maintenance, and Fire Station 1 with the Justice Center and Municipal Building. MetroNet provided the lowest quote at \$9,000/year for a 36-month term.
- Approved in its first reading Ordinance 21-03, a request to rezone 5.15 acres of land located at 675 Waldsmith Way from Residential Two-Family and Residential Four-Family to Residential Single-Family 3.
- Approved in its first reading Ordinance 21-04, amending Section 678.09 by cleaning up language and adding additional discharge language that was inadvertently left out when this Ordinance was amended in 2019.
