



Council Action

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, October 19 meeting:

- ✓ Approved Resolution 20-R-62, declaring items as surplus and granting authorization to dispose of such items either on GovDeals or otherwise, as provided by law.
- ✓ Approved Resolution 20-R-63, awarding the bid for the Buttercup Storm Sewer project to ProShot Concrete with the lowest and best bid of \$49,795. This project has a completion date of May 2021.
- ✓ Approved Resolution 20-R-64, authorizing the submission of an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for financial assistance for the Gabriel Street Reconstruction project. The estimated cost for this project is \$781,666, with survey and engineering work to be done in-house. The City will request 50% project funding, of which 25% would be a grant and 25% a no-interest loan.
- ✓ Adopted, as an emergency, Ordinance 20-28, assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to weed cutting and storm water.
- ✓ Approved multiple variances at 3350 Benchwood Road from the landscaping and screening requirements associated with a substantial building expansion with the following conditions:
 1. Mounding is installed adjacent to Benchwood Road in compliance with Code Section 1220.03(d)(8) "Landscaping and Screening" & 1232.04(e) "Mounds and Berms."
 2. The existing 5-foot wide public sidewalk, near the Ruby Tuesday property, is extended the entire length of the subject property.
 3. The subject property comes into full compliance with the interior landscaping requirements.
 4. All existing shrubs, trees, and vegetation that do not interfere with construction or paving of the proposed development shall remain.
