

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, January 6 meeting:

- Appointed Mayor Richard Herbst to the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) and the Transportation Coordinating Committee. Ms. Amber Holloway, Assistant City Manager, will serve as the alternate representative to MVRPC. Mr. Rob Cron, Director of Public Service, was appointed to the MVRPC Technical Committee.
- Appointed Mayor Richard Herbst and Vice Mayor Bob Ahlers as representatives to the First Suburbs Consortium. Councilman David Lewis will serve as an alternate.
- Appointed Mayor Herbst to the Montgomery County Community Improvement Corporation.

Appointed Mr. Dave Arnold and Ms. Arlene Setzer to the Board of Zoning Appeals.

- Adopted Resolution 20-R-01, approving the purchase of a new greens mower for Cassel Hills Golf
- Course at the lowest bid price of \$35,328.46. The bid came in \$328.46 over the budgeted amount of \$35,000. The additional monies will come out of the cart path asphalt line item. This mower will replace a 2002 mower with 1,658 service hours.
- Gave first reading to Ordinance 20-01, rezoning 0.232 acres of land located at 1 E. National Road from Office-Residential to Office Service. The subject property totals 0.723-acres and is comprised of two different zoning classifications. This rezoning would place all the property under the same zoning classification.
- Approved a variance to permit a second curb opening at 985 Falls Creek Drive for Triad Technologies.
