

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

## Council took the following actions at the Monday, May 3 meeting:



Approved Resolution 21-R-30 awarding the bid for the Curb & Sidewalk Program to Coate Construction as the low bidder at \$246,081. This project came in under our engineer's estimate of \$265,000.



Approved Resolution 21-R-31 dedicating 0.8629-acres of land as public right-of-way at 251 N. Dixie Drive.



Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 21-10 updating the Codified Ordinances. This update will codify all pertinent legislation passed by Council during 2020, as well as incorporate amendments to the Ohio Revised Code.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to eliminate the requirement for wheel stop devices on 54 existing parking spaces.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to eliminate the perimeter landscaping requirement for the rear yard.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to allow a 5.5-foot-wide front parking setback without providing screening from the public right-of-way with the following condition:



Landscaping be installed pursuant to the Applicant's proposal for a continuous hedge and ornamental tree at the two driveway entrances.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to permit a second curb opening on an interior lot.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to allow construction of a new flat-roofed building without providing a parapet wall on the east, south, and west facades and allowing the north façade's parapet to be built without a 3-dimensional cornice with the following condition:

1) A parapet wall is provided on the north facing building façade and the aluminum composite (ACM) panels project 8-inches out from the building façade.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to allow construction of a new building with less than the required 25% of total wall area being occupied by windows on the east and west facing building facades with the following condition:

1) The windows on the east and west building facades shall occupy at least 25% of the office wall area.



Approved a variance at 1090 W. National Road to allow an outdoor display, storage, and sales facility without providing full screening to the adjacent residential district subject to the following condition:

1) The existing 6-foot-tall wooden privacy fence be removed and replaced with an 8-foot-tall privacy fence.
