

RESOLUTION 21-R-11

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BODY WORN CAMERAS, SOFTWARE AND RELATED MOUNTING EQUIPMENT, REQUESTED BY THE IT DEPARTMENT, FOR THE 2021 POLICE BODY WORN CAMERA UPGRADE PROJECT AT A TOTAL PRICE OF \$60,025.30 AND DECLARING THE EQUIPMENT BEING REPLACED AS SURPLUS PROPERTY
