

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, November 1 meeting:

- ✓ Announced that the City Council Study Session of November 15, 2021 would begin at 5:00 p.m.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-68 to award the contract for the golf course restroom building project to VanCon General Contractors in an amount not to exceed \$75,000. Council will allocate American Rescue Plan funds to cover the costs of this restroom facility.
- Approved a variance to allow for a total of 92.8 square feet of drive-thru signage for property located at 6425 Miller Lane with the condition that the signs be screened to 75% opacity in all seasons. The Code permits 62 square feet of drive-thru sign area, however if the signs are completely screened from the public right-of-way, there is no maximum square footage.
- ▼ Denied a variance request to permit roof-mounted solar panels to face a public street at 505 Tionda Drive. The Code permits roof-mounted solar panels on roof surfaces that do not face the street.
- Approved a variance to allow 21 loading spaces in the front yard for a proposed warehouse development at 1005 Top Notch Court provided that landscaping must be installed in accordance with City Code Section 1232.06 (b) for both the I-75 and Deer Run Road loading areas. The Code permits loading docks in side or rear yards, but not front yards.
- Approved a variance to allow two curb openings on the same street frontage at 1005 Top Notch Court with the condition that a median be placed within each curb opening to ensure the exiting traffic turns right. The Code permits one curb opening on each street frontage on corner lots.
