

In an effort to increase awareness and understanding, this publication was created to detail and explain the actions of the Vandalia City Council. We hope this promotes a better understanding of the role Council plays in keeping Vandalia a great place to live, work and play.

Council took the following actions at the Monday, December 20 meeting:

- Mayor Herbst presented a proclamation honoring Mr. Joe Dranschak, President of the Historical Society of Vandalia-Butler, for his dedication in preserving local history. On Tuesday, December 21, 2021 we celebrated Joseph Albert Dranschak Day in the City of Vandalia.
- City Manager Wendt and Finance Director Leiter introduced Michelle Weber who was recently appointed to the full-time Administrative Assistant role in the Finance Department.
- ▼ Reappointed Mr. Frank Keish and Mr. Peter Breidenbach to the Local Board of Tax Review.
- Approved Resolution 21-R-76 authorizing an agreement between the Auditor of State, Plattenburg and Associates, and the City of Vandalia for audit services and compilation services to prepare and file the annual report.
- Approved with one condition, in its first reading, Ordinance 21-37 a Planned Unit Development Major Amendment for the Cassel Hills Planned Unit Development to accommodate section line adjustments between Cassel Hills Section 3 and Section 4.
- Approved, in its first reading, Ordinance 21-38 amending City Code Section 452.03(a)(14) to increase driver safety related to the enforcement of commercial vehicle traffic and parking violations along interstate ramps.
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 21-33 to amend the Zoning Code in order to create a new district called "Industrial/Innovation".
- Approved, in its second reading, Ordinance 21-34 a rezoning of 470 acres of land generally located west of Airport Access Road to the western city limits from Agriculture, Highway Business, and Office/Industrial Park to Industrial Innovation.
- ✓ Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-35 amending 2021 appropriations.
- Approved, as an emergency, Ordinance 21-36 assessing properties for delinquent accounts related to storm water fees, trash collection, weed cutting & sewer and water.
