RESOLUTION 22-R-08

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AWARDING THE FIREWORKS DISPLAY CONTRACT FOR THE 2022 STAR SPANGLED CELEBRATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,000 AND FOR THE 2023 STAR SPANGLED CELEBRATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,000 TO ROZZI'S FAMOUS FIREWORKS COMPANY

The resolution, which bears the foregoing title, was unanimously approved Monday, February 7, 2022, by the Council of the City of Vandalia. The resolution waives the formal bidding process and awards the fireworks display contract for the 2022 Star Spangled Celebration in the amount of \$28,000 and for the 2023 Star Spangled Celebration in the amount of \$29,000 to Rozzi's Famous Fireworks Company. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 874.08(i); 1420.01; 1424.01; 1424.05; 1482.01(g); 1482.20 AND 1610.01 OF THE VANDALIA CODIFIED ORDINANCES BY TO UPDATE SPECIFIC REFERENCES TO CURRENT BUILDING CODES AND FIRE CODES
