# Let's Talk Chickens!



## Can I have chickens on my property?

Chickens are permitted as an accessory use in the A, RSF-1, RSF-2, RSF-3, RSF-4 and PUD Zoning Districts when the lot is 2 acres or larger.

## How many chickens can I have?

2 chickens per acre, with a maximum of 8 chickens per property, regardless of acreage.

#### Can I have a rooster?

No individual shall keep a rooster.

## Can I sell eggs or chickens from my residential property?

No individual shall sell chickens or products produced by chickens.





### Do I need a permit for a chicken coop?

Yes, if the coop is greater than 50 square feet. Please note that all coops and pens will need to be setback at least 25 feet from any lot line.
