



TRIVIA

Event Sponsor: Kona Ice

EVENT DESCRIPTION: Trivia is for the entire team. The team accumulating the most points during the contest will be declared the winner.

LOCATION/DATE/TIME: Sports Complex (Baseball Concession) / Friday, June 6 / 7:00 p.m.

EQUIPMENT: Team Jerseys are not required. VPRD will provide all the necessary equipment. Team Banners must be displayed to be eligible for bonus points.

RULES AND FORMAT:

1. The entire team (20-25 members) is encouraged to participate. Each team must have a minimum of one (1) male and one (1) female participant in order to compete.
2. ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED in the playing area. If a player is noticed with a device in sight (regardless of its purpose), she/he will be required to leave the game playing area and a penalty will be assessed (see rule #5). He/she will be permitted back into the game at the start of the next round.
 - a. Examples of electronic devices include, but are not limited to phones, smart watches, ear phones, tablets, etc. These devices are permitted in a player's pocket, but they are not permitted in eye sight or in a strategic location where a team could extract answers.
 - b. If a player has to use an electronic device during a round, they may do so AFTER they leave the table. Once they leave the table, they are not permitted back into the game until the next round.
3. Team participants must be sitting or standing next to the table their team is playing. If a participant must leave the table during a round, that person is not permitted back until the next round. Folks not participating are not permitted close to the table that their co-workers are playing (see rule #7). Walking back and forth between a team's playing area and outside the playing area is not permitted.
4. Communicating with non-participating teammates is not permitted during a round. If a participant needs to communicate with a non-participant, he/she may do so, outside of the playing area, and they are not permitted to return to participate until the next round.

5. PENALTIES: Teams that do not abide by the rules and/or are considered to be compromising the integrity of the event will be deducted 50% of their points for the round in question. A second infraction will result in disqualification of the event and will receive zero points for the event.
6. The City's goal is to have enough volunteers so there can be one volunteer observing each participating team to ensure rules are being followed. Opposing teams may locate a player at another team's table to assist City staff with rules enforcement. City staff will have the final say on rule interpretations.
7. Non-participants must be at least 20' away from their teams playing area. A non-participant can choose to play, but only at the beginning of a round. They cannot enter a round once the round has started. Staff can further the distance, if needed.
8. Each team will record their answers to a variety of questions on a scoresheet. The score sheet will be collected at the conclusion of each round and tallied.
9. The team accumulating the most points after all rounds have been completed and points tallied will be declared the winner of the event.
10. A detailed explanation of the rules and regulations of the competition will be conducted prior to the start of the event by the trivia host.

SCORING:

1st Place - 35 Points
2nd Place - 25 Points
3rd Place - 20 Points
4th Place - 15 Points

5th Place - 13 Points
6th Place - 12 Points
7th Place - 11 Points
8th Place - 10 Points
