

CORNHOLE

Event Sponsor: VANDALIA-BUTLER OPTIMIST CLUB

<u>EVENT DESCRIPTION</u>: Two (2) male and two (2) female participant per team will join together to compete in a double elimination Cornhole Tournament. Cornhole participants are not permitted to play in the Euchre Event and vice versa.

LOCATION/ DATE/ TIME: Helke Park/ Thursday, June 5 / 6:00 p.m.

<u>EQUIPMENT:</u> Team jerseys must be worn to be eligible for bonus points. VPRD will provide all the necessary equipment. Team Banners must be displayed to be eligible for bonus points.

RULES AND FORMAT:

- 1. Each team will have a male and female playing at each board. Each player will throw two bags during their round.
- 2. Scoring: Games are played to **twenty-one** points (or over... no bust). 11-0 is a skunk and ends the game. Points are scored according to the position of the bags at the end of each round.
 - a. At the end of the round, 3 points for each bag in the hole and 1 point for each bag on the board.
 - b. Score is the difference in the team totals. For example: after one round (8 bags played) team #1 has one bag in the hole and three bags missed the board for 3 points. Team #2 has 2 bags on the board and two bags missed the board for 2 points. Team #1 would score one point for the round and would be the first team to throw to start the next round.
 - c. There is no score for the following situations:
 - 1. bag tossed when a player foot fouls
 - 2. bag knocked off the board
 - 3. How to determine if a bag hanging off the lower edge of the board counts? An official will lift the board up. If the bag falls off it does not count, if the bag stays on it counts.
 - 4. bag tossed out of turn
 - d. Teams will keep their own game scores. If a decision on points can't be met by the teams, then a Corporate Challenge official shall make a decision.
- 3. Choice of first toss for the start of each match will be determined by rock, paper, scissor or coin toss. After the start of the match, then first toss in a round will be by the team that last scored a point.

- 4. Each tosser must remain behind the front edge of the board while tossing. Any bag delivered while the tosser's foot extends beyond the front edge of the board shall be declared a foul and no score will be counted for that bag. Underhand toss only.
- 5. After teams have thrown all bags, do not touch bags until both teams agree on the score.
- 6. Each team will have four (4) bags to toss per round. A1 tosses one bag, followed by opponent B1 tossing one bag. Next, A2 tosses one bag followed by opponent B2. Repeat this rotation a second time and this will constitute one round. The round is scored after all 8 bags are played. Repeat play from the other board. The team that last scores a point will go first. This rotation will continue throughout the game.
- 7. No player shall touch any bags until points of a round have been agreed upon or Challenge Officials render a decision.
- 8. The boards will be 25 feet apart, inside box frame to inside box frame.
