RESOLUTION 15-R-55

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THREE CRUISER IN-CAR CAMERAS, REQUESTED BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE, TO CDW-G IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,901.45

WHEREAS, the Division of Police regularly rotates the purchase of in car patrol cameras and has provided for new purchases in every three years in the same rotation as patrol cars; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to maintain consistency, centralized management with such equipment; and

WHEREAS, CDW-G is the registered and authorized Panasonic reseller for this project; and

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum from Doug Knight, Chief of Police, recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and authorize the purchase of three Panasonic cruiser in-car cameras from CDW-G; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e)(1) and(5).

<u>Section 2</u>. Council authorizes the purchase by the Clty Manager or his designee of three Panasonic in-car cameras requested by the Division of Police, from CDW-G in the total amount amount of \$15,904.45 and authorizes the City Manager or his designee to execute any and all documents necessary and proper to finalize the transaction.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and in conformance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
