RESOLUTION 15-R-16

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE FOR A 2016 INTERNATIONAL 4300 LP MEDIC, REQUESTED BY THE FIRE DIVISION, TO HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$198,373.90 AND DECLARING THE EXISTING 2001 FORD F350 MEDIC AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum and bid tabulation from Chief Follick recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and award the bid from the State of Ohio bid price for one 2016 International 4300 LP Medic; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e)(2).
- <u>Section 2</u>. Council awards the bid from the State of Ohio bid price for one 2016 International 4300 LP Medic to Horton Emergency Vehicles at the lowest and best bid price of \$198,373.90.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Council declares the existing 2001 Ford F350 Medic as surplus property and approves placing it on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City manager as provided by law after delivery of the new medic.
- <u>Section 4.</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and in conformance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
