RESOLUTION 14-R-49

A RESOLUTION WAIVING THE FORMAL BIDDING PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE FOR FIVE MOTOROLA 800MHz MOBILE REQUESTED BY THE DIVISION OF FIRE. FROM COMMUNICATIONS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,357 AND DECLARING THE EXISTING EQUIPMENT BEING REPLACED AS SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Council has received a memorandum and recommendation from Chief Follick recommending Council waive the formal bidding process and authorize the purchase for five Motorola 800MHz mobile radios; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e), Council has the authority to waive the formal bidding process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANDALIA, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Council waives the formal bidding process pursuant to Vandalia Code section 208.02(e)(1) as the purchase consists of goods or services, or any combination thereof, for which only one source of supply is reasonably available;
- Section 2. Council authorizes the purchase for five Motorola 800MHz mobile radios to P&R Communications in the amount of \$22,357 as P&R Communications and Motorola are proprietary radio vendors.
- Section 3. Council declares the existing 2001 800 MHz mobile radios as surplus property and approves placing them on GovDeals or otherwise disposed of by the City manager as provided by law after delivery of the new radios.
- <u>Section 3</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
