# ANDALIA "CHISELED" SEPTEMBER 4—18, 2010

Vandalia "Chiseled" was a two-week stone sculpture symposium featuring five nationally-recognized artists who used the Vandalia Recreation Center south lot as their studio and large blocks of Indiana limestone as their canvas. Over 100 community volunteers acted as docents to the estimated 6,000 visitors which included more than 2,400 local students. An

array of opportunities enabled the community to interact with the artists. Local organizations, businesses, and citizens participated in the various events. The goal of acquiring permanent public art became an exciting community event with many lasting memo-




ries. In 2011, PAIV finalized the permanent locations for the sculptures and planned the five installations. The dedication event, Chiseled *Unveiled*, took place on September 18, 2011 with an "art crawl" to the five locations and an afternoon full of art activities.


